

Pamoja Statement on the Presidential Audit of Mining Revenues and State Assets in the Democratic Republic of the Congo

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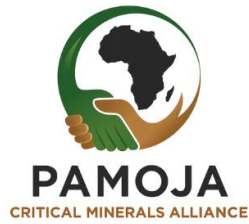
Pamoja welcomes and strongly supports the decision by His Excellency Félix Tshisekedi, President of the Democratic Republic of Congo, to launch a comprehensive audit of mining export revenues and state assets.

This initiative represents a critical step toward strengthening transparency, accountability, and economic sovereignty in the governance of the country's strategic mineral resources.

The Democratic Republic of the Congo is among the world's most resource-rich nations, holding vast reserves of copper, cobalt, lithium, gold, and coltan. These minerals are central to global supply chains for clean energy technologies, batteries, and advanced electronics. Concerns around weak oversight, opaque financial practices, and inefficiencies in revenue collection have limited the country's ability to fully benefit from record mineral exports.

Pamoja recognizes this audit as a historic opportunity to strengthen transparency in the mining sector, combat corruption and illicit financial flows, improve governance of state-owned mining assets, and ensure fair distribution of national resource wealth. Despite exceptional mineral production, many Congolese citizens continue to face poverty and limited public services. This initiative is essential to ensure resource wealth translates into development. Pamoja calls upon all stakeholders including government institutions, mining companies, financial institutions, civil society, and international partners to fully cooperate with this audit process.

We further urge transparency, public release of findings, and implementation of corrective reforms where necessary.



The future of the Democratic Republic of the Congo must be defined not only by extraction of resources but by how these resources improve lives. Pamoja stands firmly for transparency, accountability, economic justice, and inclusive development.
